The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah dba Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Schedules No. AA, A-1, A-9, B-2, and B-6 of its tariff filed on July 8, 2020. Frontier's filing proposes modifications to grandfather its Wide Area Telecommunications Service Offering and includes supporting administrative changes. Frontier requests an effective date of August 10, 2020 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on July 14, 2020. DPU states it does not object to Frontier's proposed grandfathering of the service and recommends the PSC approve the requested tariff revisions.
