The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Schedule No. A-3 of its tariff filed on August 18, 2020. Frontier's filing proposes modifications to introduce Frontier Residential Unlimited Voice, effective September 20, 2020.
