The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah dba Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Sheet Nos. 1 and 8 of its Schedule No. A-1, Network Access Line Service ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 29, 2020. The purpose of this filing is to reduce the Federal Lifeline support for voice-only Lifeline service from \$7.25 per month per Lifeline subscriber to \$5.25, as a result of the FCC's Lifeline Modernization Order, WC Docket No. 11-42, issued April 27, 2016. Frontier requests an effective date of December 1, 2020 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 9, 2020. The DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve Frontier's proposed revisions to the Tariff.

Based on its review of Frontier's Tariff and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Frontier's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective December 1, 2020.
