The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") has reviewed the notice by Qwest Communications International Inc. and CenturyTel, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") and recommends that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledge the receipt of this notice.

Explanation

On or about March 03, 2020, CenturyLink notified the Commission that it will start integration of its new Operational Support System. During 2020, CenturyLink seeks to transition all Local Service Request order processing to its Electronic Administration & Service Order Exchange system. The attached plan outlines CenturyLink's planned methodical migration of order processing off the Interconnect Mediated Access system and onto the EASE system across all markets and geographies by October 16, 2020.
