Dear Ms. Matushek,

On April 15, 2020, Navajo filed its Annual Report for Calendar Year 2019 ("Report") with the Public Service Commission (PSC). On May 21, 2020, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed its recommendation with the PSC stating that, based on its review of the Report, Navajo does not qualify for Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Support Fund ("UUSF") payments in calendar year 2021. The DPU noted that the PSC is currently not paying assistance to Navajo and that no adjustments to the UUSF eligibility for Navajo are necessary. On June 4, 2020, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period, seeking comments on DPU's recommendation by July 6, 2020, and reply comments by July 21, 2020. The PSC received no comments.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report, and on DPU's uncontested recommendation, and there being no comments or reply comments filed during the comment period, the PSC finds and concludes that Navajo does not qualify for a disbursement from the UUSF in 2021 under Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-15. The PSC will take no further action in this Docket.
