The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company's ("Navajo") proposed revisions to Section 8 of its General Exchange Tariff – Utah ("Tariff") filed on August 18, 2020. Navajo's filing proposes modifications to introduce Navajo Residential Unlimited Voice, effective September 20, 2020.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on August 31, 2020. DPU states it does not object to Navajo's proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve the requested Tariff revisions.

Based on the PSC's review of Navajo's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, and the lack of any opposition, the PSC approves Navajo's proposed revisions to Section 8 of its Tariff as filed, effective September 20, 2020.
