The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc.'s ("SCUTA") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 24 of its P.S.C. Utah No. 5, Lifeline Telephone Assistance Program Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 30, 2020. The purpose of this filing is to reduce the Federal Lifeline support for voice-only Lifeline service from \$7.25 per month per Lifeline subscriber to \$5.25, as a result of the FCC's Lifeline Modernization Order, WC Docket No. 11-42, issued April 27, 2016. SCUTA requests an effective date of December 1, 2020 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 9, 2020. The DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve SCUTA's proposed revisions to the Tariff.

Based on its review of SCUTA's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves SCUTA's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective December 1, 2020.
