Dear Ms. Slawson,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed UBTA-UBET Communications Inc.'s ("UBTA-UBET") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 3.3 and 234.1 of its P.S.C.U. No. 1 Exchange Carriers of Utah Access Service Tariff ("Tariff"), filed June 1, 2020. UBTA-UBET states the proposed changes reflect the leveling of rates as prescribed by FCC rules and requests an effective date of July 1, 2020 for these changes.

As an initial matter, UBTA-UBET did not file a statement that its proposed tariff revisions do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule, as required under Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g). The PSC requests that UBTA-UBET meet this requirement in future filings. We conclude, without prejudice to dissimilar conclusions in future filings, that in this instance this deficiency is not material enough to be a basis to suspend or deny the tariff.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 11, 2020. DPU states the proposed tariff changes are consistent with the FCC's prescribed rules and transition of charges. DPU recommends the PSC approve UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to its Local Transport-LTR and Local Switching-LTR intrastate access rates as filed.

Based on its review of UBTA-UBET's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, effective July 1, 2020.
