### Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) recommends that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) acknowledge the requested name change from TeleQuality Communications, LLC to ENA Healthcare Services, LLC.

The Division expects that, based on history that a filing of this type and with the information submitted by the company, there will be no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with R746-110-1.

## **Explanation**

On or about March 24, 2020, TeleQuality Communications, LLC filed a letter with the Commission indicating the company will be changing its name to ENA Healthcare Services, LLC, which became effective in Utah on February 18, 2020. The name change will not impact any customers in the state of Utah. Additionally, ENA Healthcare Services, LLC will not change the services it offers. The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the request by ENA Healthcare Services, LLC to change its corporate name and make the necessary changes and amendments to all the required documents.
