The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed UBTA-UBET Communications Inc.'s ("UBTA-UBET") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 3.3 and 234.1 of its P.S.C.U. No. 1 Access Service Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on May 26, 2021. The purpose of this filing is to comply with Federal Communications Commission amended rules that implement 8YY access charge reform. This reform requires all rate-of-return incumbent local exchange carriers to modify originating 8YY rates in the following groups: End Office/Local Switching, Transport, and Query Charge. UBTA-UBET requests an effective date of July 1, 2021 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 8, 2021. DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to the Tariff with the requested effective date. According to DPU, the Tariff revisions will bring UBTA-UBET's rates to the required levels.

Based on the PSC's review of UBTA-UBET's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective July 1, 2021.
