Dear Mr. Hendricks,

On March 31, 2022, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) Amendments (“Amendments”) to the Interconnection Agreement with American Messaging Services, LLC in Docket Nos. 22-049-58 and 22-049-59 (the “Dockets”). The proposed Amendments address reciprocal compensation to be at bill and keep by adding terms and conditions and the routing of traffic through a third-party transit provider, respectively.

On April 5, 2022, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed joint comments addressing both Dockets, and recommending in both cases that the PSC acknowledge receipt of the Amendments. DPU states that the Amendments were voluntarily negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination, and it sees no reason to reject the Amendments.

Based on DPU’s comments and recommendation and in the absence of any opposition to the Amendments, the PSC acknowledges the Amendments. The Amendments are deemed approved by operation of federal law under 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), effective June 29, 2022.
