On January 24, 2023 five days later a CenturyLink technician named Justin came to my house and told me that a Company by the name of "BRIGHAM DIRECTIONAL DIGGINGS" cut the line while digging through the neighborhood back yards to install 6-inch diameter pipe 5 feet underground so CenturyLink could install FIBEROPTICS. Justin said he will install a temporary line for us. Today Tuesday February 14, 2023 our phone and internet is working fine even during the rain and snow storms. I do not know if the temporary line has been replaced with a permanent line or not.
- 3. <u>Today February 14, 2023, my phone and internet are working, and as long as they are working, I am SATISFIED.</u>
