Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) recommends that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) acknowledge the requested name change from Magna5 LLC to RingSquared Telecom LLC.

The Division expects that, based on history that a filing of this type and with the information submitted by the company, there will be no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with R746-110-1.

Discussion

On or about June 23, 2022, Magna5 LLC filed a letter with the Commission indicating the company will be changing its name to RingSquared Telecom LLC (“RingSquared”) effective May 04, 2022. The name change will not impact any customers in the state of Utah.
