**Re:** **Docket No. 23-049-T01**, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC's Tariff Revisions. This is the third step in implementing the 8YY originating access charges to comply with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 8YY Reform Order.

## Recommendation (Approve Tariff Sheets)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") has reviewed the tariff filing and recommends the Public Service Commission ("Commission") approve Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC's ("CenturyLink") request to revise the 8YY Access Charge Rates. The Division therefore recommends the tariff change become effective on July 1, 2023.

## Discussion

On June 23, 2023, CenturyLink submitted to the Commission its third step in the implementation of the originating access charges to comply with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 8YY Reform Order. The Division has reviewed the redlined version of the tariff sheets submitted with the Company's filing and has no objections to the proposed revisions. Therefore, the Division recommends the Commission approve this filing as submitted, with an effective date of July 1, 2023, as requested.
