Re: Docket Nos. 23-2586-01 and 23-2628-01, *Joint Application of ExteNet Systems, LLC and ExteNet Asset Entity, LLC for Approval to Transfer Certain Assets Between Applicants*

All,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the joint applications of ExteNet Systems, LLC and ExteNet Asset Entity, LLC (collectively, the "Applicants") providing notice of the proposed transfer of certain assets, including customer contracts and related telecommunications network infrastructure, and a request for a waiver of state and federal anti-slamming provisions to transfer customer contracts, filed July 26, 2023 ("Notification"). The Notification seeks approval to the extent necessary. The Notification describes the Applicants, explains the transaction, and provides certain information consistent with Utah Admin. Code R746-349-7.

The Notification states the transfer of assets including customer contracts and related telecommunications network infrastructure will be seamless to the customers with the Applicants providing service pursuant to the same terms, conditions, and rates to existing customers.

The PSC has also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) comments, filed August 7, 2023. The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Notification and states the public interest will be promoted by the PSC acknowledging the Notification. The DPU does not address whether the proposed transfer requires PSC approval.

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Accordingly, the PSC acknowledges the filing of the Notification and gives notice it will take no further action in these dockets unless a party files a request for action and explains the jurisdictional basis on which the PSC may or should act.
