RE: Activation of Codes

Dear Chairman Mecham:

On December 4, 2000 I wrote a letter on behalf of Level 3 Communications, LLC ("Level 3") requesting the grant of an extension of time in which to place certain NPA codes into service. As of today's date, Level 3 has been able to activate five (5) of the total of six (6) codes that were the subject of the previous letter.

Level 3 has requested and been assigned six NPA codes in Utah by NANPA Code Administration. They are 435-213, 435-214, 435-215, 801-783, 801-784 and 801-788. Each of these six codes had an in-service due date of December 13, 2000. Because of a myriad of factors relating to the fact that Level 3 is building an entirely new network from the ground up, Level 3 was unable to activate its codes by the in-service due date. Level 3 has continued to work diligently to activate these codes as quickly as possible. I am writing to inform the Commission that Level 3 has successfully activated all but one of the codes above today. Level 3 anticipates activating the remaining code, 435-215, in the coming days.

Thank you for your attention to and consideration of this matter. A copy of this letter is being sent to Anthony Davi at Nuestar, Inc. to inform them of this development. Further, I will immediately notify the Commission and NANPA when the remaining code 435-215 is activated. At this time, Level 3 will proceed on the assumption that it will not have its codes reclaimed and will continue to use them as we have planned.
