PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On February 16, 2000, Petitioner ICG Telecom Group, Inc., sought Commission approval for an expanded Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to encompass providing facilities-based as well as resold local telephone exchange carrier services. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU). DPU filed a memorandum February 16, 2000, recommending approval of the petition. No detriment to the public interest appearing we enter the following

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2259, issued to ICG Telecom Group, Inc., be, and it is, amended, to authorize said Certificate Holder to offer and provided facilities-based, as well as resold, local exchange carrier telephone service.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
