PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On July 13, 2000, Petitioner, Worldwide Fiber Networks, Inc., sought approval of a name change to 360networks (USA) inc. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), for review and recommendation, and the DPU filed its memorandum recommending approval September 21, 2000. Petitioner filed its proof of qualification to do business in Utah on November 20, 2000. No detriment to the public interest appearing, and an evidentiary hearing on the matter appearing to be superfluous, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

The proposed name change be, and it is, approved and the records of the Commission be amended to show the owner of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2289 to be 360networks (USA) inc.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
