PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On September 12, 2000, Petitioner MGC Communications, Inc., filed its Petition seeking a name change to MPOWER COMMUNICATIONS CORP. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum recommending approval November 16, 2000. Since there appears to be no detriment to the public interest, and an evidentiary hearing on the matter appearing to be superfluous, we have determined to dispose of the matter summarily. Accordingly we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

The proposed name change is approved and that the records of the Commission be amended to reflect the holder of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2307 to be MPOWER COMMUNICATIONS CORP.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
