# PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On September 18, 2001, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Petitioner herein, submitted for Commission approval an amendment to the existing interconnection agreement between USWC and ESCHELON TELECOM OF UTAH, INC. The amendment related to five issues: Unbundled Network Elements, Local Interconnection Service, Bill and keep reciprocal compensation, Monthly recurring charges, and Non-recurring charges. The parties later withdrew the amendment regarding Local Interconnection Service. The matter was submitted for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU) which filed its memorandum recommending approval of the same November 30, 2001. The proposed amendment does not appear to contravene established law, nor does it appear to be contrary to the public interest. Accordingly, we enter the following
