PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On August 21, 2001, Rhythms Links, Inc., (RLI) a certificated telephone corporation, filed with the Commission a notice that it was discontinuing broad band service to Utah customers. Enclosed was a document RLI had filed with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) seeking approval of service nation wide. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU) which recommended approval in a memorandum dated October 9, 2001. RLI having apparently complied with Federal Law which preempts any jurisdiction we might otherwise have in the matter, we enter the following<u>ORDER</u>

1. The Commission acquiesces in RLI's termination of broad-band service within the State of Utah.

2. Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
