By The Commission:

By letter received July 31, 2003, XO Utah, Inc. ("XO") seeks six one-thousand number blocks-specifically the blocks to be: 2,3,4,6,7,8 in the same NXX within the Provo rate Center. On July 8, 2003, the Division of Public Utilities was contacted by Donald Nay, Associate Public Works Director of the Public Works Department of Utah County. He informed the Division that a new facility was being constructed at 151 South University in Provo that would be called the Utah County Health and Justice Building. He stated that it was the intent of Utah County to consolidate a number of Utah County departments into this one building. Mr. Nay stated that the move into the new building would be in December, 2003, and that 6,000 direct in dialing (DID) numbers would be required. At present, Utah County is using 3,600 DIDs in the separate facilities. Mr. Nay stated that there would be a necessary transition time when both the old numbers and the new numbers would be active, but upon deactivation, that the old 3,600 numbers would be returned to the number pool for use by others.

The Division of Public Utilities investigated and filed its recommendation. The Division's memorandum states that the distribution of the new number blocks and the granting of the waiver should be accompanied with the stipulation that the existing 3,600 DID numbers will be returned to the Qwest number pool from whence they were ported upon completion of the transition period. The Division recommends approval of the requested waiver.

We agree with the analysis and recommendation of the Division.

ORDER

The request of XO Utah, Inc. for a waiver for Six One Thousand Blocks in NPA 801 in the Provo Rate Center is granted, consistent with the Division recommendation.
