SYNOPSIS

Comcast is granted approval to discontinue its Comcast Digital Phone service to Utah residential customers, on or after September 30 , 2007.

By The Commission:

On August 9, 2007, Comcast Phone of Utah LLC (Comcast) filed an Application to discontinue what it calls its Comcast Digital Phone service to Utah residential customers. The proposal is in furtherance of Comcast's plans to introduce an alternative residential voice service in the Utah market. The application and discontinuance process are made pursuant to Utah Administrative Code Rule R746-350. By Memorandum, dated August 27, 2007, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) provides a summary of its review of Comcast's proposal and discontinuance notices. The DPU recommends the Commission approve the Application. No other responses have been submitted to Comcast's Application.

Upon review of Comcasts's Application and the DPU's Memorandum, we conclude that we will grant Comcast's Application. We find that Comcast has complied with the requirements of Rule 350 and has provided appropriate notice to its customers, other telecommunications carriers and the North American Numbering Plan Administrator to allow

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service to cease on the proposed date of September 30, 2007. Comcast's customers have the opportunity of transferring service to a replacement service provider or to Comcast's alternative residential voice service.

Wherefore, we enter the ORDER whereby we:

1. Grant Comcast Phone of Utah, LLC's Application
2. Comcast Phone of Utah, LLC may discontinue Comcast Digital Phone service to its Utah residential customers on or after September 30, 2007.

Pursuant to *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 63-46b-12 and 54-7-15, agency review or rehearing of this order may be obtained by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 63-46b-14, 63-46b-16 and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
