By The Commission:

This matter is before the Commission on David Young's formal complaint against Qwest. The Division of Public Utilities (Division) submitted its recommendation on July 13, 2009. Mr. Young reduced his service with Qwest to "anywhere voice mail" on October 6, 2008. He claims that shortly after making the change, persons calling his number from a Verizon or T-Mobile wireless line would receive a message that his number was no longer in service. He stated he contacted Qwest's customer service to fix the issue, but it had not been fixed.

The Division stated that Qwest's Executive Office referred Mr. Young's issue to a Network Escalations Manager to investigate. She contacted Mr. Young to gather the numbers that were trying to call his number, but Qwest was unable to obtain from Mr. Young the numbers that were having the problems calling his phone. She put in a repair ticket for the customer, and the repair department was unable to duplicate the problem.

The Division also called Mr. Young's number from a T-Mobile number and was able to get through to his voice mail, but it gave a message stating "this voice mail box is full." The Division states that Mr. Young has not cooperated with Qwest in helping resolve the issue, nor has he established that Qwest violated any Utah laws, rules or tariffs.

On August 11, 2009 the Commission was informed that Mr. Young had reached a resolution with his service providers and he sent an email to the Division stating that his complaint by withdrawn.

ORDER

Therefore, the Commission finds that Mr. Young has not established any violation of Utah law, Commission rules, or company tariff by Qwest. The Commission also finds that Mr. Young negotiated with both Qwest and Verizon and his service issues were resolved. Mr. Young, therefore, withdrew his complaint.
