Notice is hereby given that the above-entitled matter will be heard before the Public Service Commission of Utah on Wednesday the 26th day of January, 2000, at 9:00 a.m., Fourth Floor Hearing Room, room #426, Heber M. Wells State Office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. Pursuant to U.C.A. 54-7-12(4), the Commission will consider whether this tariff should remain suspended, be denied, altered, or approved.

Specifically the Commission desires to hear evidence concerning whether the proposed prices comply with U.C.A. 54-8b-3.3. The evidence on file with the Commission primarily focuses on revenue streams rather than total service long-run incremental costs of non-essential facilities and the price of essential facilities as required by the statute.

The Commission directs that the Petitioner explain, as part of the testimony, any deviations in the methodologies or amounts of these costs from the unbundled network element pricing methodology previously discussed before the Commission in Docket number 94-999-01.
