SYNOPSIS

No detriment to the public interest appearing, the Commission approved the name change.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On December 23, 1999, Petitioner Telco Holdings, Inc., dba Dial & Save, sought Commission approval for a name change to Teleglobe Business Solutions, Inc. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU) for review and recommendation. DPU filed a memorandum recommending approval February 14, 2000. A search of the Utah Division of Corporations and Commercial Code web site discloses that the name change has been effected with that agency and that Petitioner is in good standing with the applicable law. No detriment to the public interest appearing, we enter the following

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Commission's records be, and they are, amended to show the name of the holder of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2213 as "Teleglobe Business Solutions, Inc.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
