On June 28, 1999, the Applicant's parent affiliate, Teligent, Inc., of which Applicant is wholly-owned subsidiary, petitioned the Commission for transfer of its operating authority to Applicant. The matter was referred to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce, for review, which filed its recommendation for approval August 13, 1999. There appearing to be no reason to convene a hearing, and no opposition to the transfer having emerged, we have determined to dispose of the matter without further proceedings. The Administrative Law Judge, having been fully advised in the matter, now enters the following Report, containing proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and the Order based thereon.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The same personnel will be active in managing Applicant as are active in managing its parent. Since we have already found the parent fit, we must also so find the subsidiary. The same reasoning applies to Applicant's financial and regulatory fitness.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The application should be granted.

<u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2248 be, and it is, transferred from JATO Communications Corp. To TELIGENT SERVICES, INC...

The records of the Commission be amended accordingly to reflect TELIGENT SERVICES, INC., as the certificate holder.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
