On February 1, 2000 the Commission issued an Order approving a name change for Eclipse Telecommunications, Inc. to BroadWing Telecommunications, Inc. and amending the carrier name on Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2264 to BroadWing Telecommunications, Inc. The Commission has since discovered that Certificate No. 2264 was originally issued to Eclipse Communications, Inc. a wholly owned subsidiary of Western Wireless Corporation, which, other than the similarity in name, has no relation to Eclipse Telecommunications, Inc., a distinct and different company operated by Cincinnati Bell, Inc.

Wherefore, the Commission hereby rescinds its February 1, 2000, Order and vacates that Order's amendment to Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2264 to identify the certificated entity's name as BroadWing Telecommunications, Inc.
