PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Access 21 Corporation dba New Edge Networks notified the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), that it had changed its name to New Edge Network, Inc., dba New Edge Networks because the name "Access 21" had already been used in several states. The DPU filed a memorandum recommending approval of the name change October 8, 1999. No opposition having emerged, and none appearing likely, and no evidentiary hearing appearing to be necessary or convenient for the disposition of this matter, we have determined to dispose of it without further proceedings. No detriment to the public interest appearing, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Commission's records be, and they are, amended to reflect the name of the holder of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 2287 to be "NEW EDGE NETWORK, INC., dba NEW EDGE NETWORKS"
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
