By The Commission:

A scheduling conference in this matter was held on June 16, 2004. Lee Kapoloski represented Wolf Creek Water and Sewer Company (“Company”). Ted Barnes represented some customers of Wolf Creek Water. Patricia Schmidt represented the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”).

At a hearing on January 21, 2004, the parties agreed to the establishment of interim rates for the Company with those rates to remain in effect until an order has issued in Docket 03-2417-01 – the application of a related entity, Wolf Creek Water Conservancy, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. Notwithstanding that no order has yet issued in Docket 03-2417-01, at the scheduling conference, the parties agreed to renew efforts aimed at resolving this ongoing rate case. To that end, the following schedule was agreed to and is hereby implemented:

June 25, 2004            Division provides data request to Company.

July 9, 2004            Company submits written reply.

Further proceedings will be set as determined by the Commission.

In issuing this Order, the parties are reminded of their continuing obligation to comply with the Commission’s Order of January 27, 2004.
