Dear Commissioners;

Following are some additional items we would like the Commission to consider. I talked with Paul Hicken on March 11, 2008, and he suggested that I send these to you at this time, even though some of the items might require a separate hearing.

1. Customers on the Conservation Tariff who have an irrigation right must use 24,000 gallons per month (48,000 in a two month billing cycle) before the irrigation right will apply. The second 12,000 will be billed at the 1st tier overage rate (\$2.00 per 1000 gallons). Once the culinary and irrigation allotments are used the 2nd tier overage rate (\$3.00 per 1000 gallons) will apply.
2. The various rates under the existing tariff will be renumbered with the number 1 being the rate with the smallest allocation of water; i.e., the conservation tariff.
3. Dammeron Valley Water Works will be allowed to collect a \$25.00 administration fee for helping with and tracking the sale or lease of an irrigation right.
4. Dammeron Valley Water Works is proposing a Bulk Sale Irrigation Rate of \$.10 per 1000 gallons for use in excess of 250 acre feet per year. This is necessary in order for us to keep our water rights in use which are being held for future development.

The first three items are mainly for clarification and administrative adjustments. All of these items were discussed at a public meeting held with Dammeron Valley Landowners on March 11th. I will be in attendance at the hearing scheduled for 1:30 PM on March 25th. If you have any questions in the meantime please contact me at (435) 680-2295.
