

Request to Intervene In: Rate Increase of Hidden Creek Water Company DOCKET NO. 09-2440-01

We request that more investigative analysis be accomplished with regards to Hidden Creek Water Company's past agreements with property owners, bookkeeping and accounting practices and reasonableness of water service and payments to Hidden Creek owners before a rate increase is finalized.

We understand that there is a technical conference scheduled on April 22, 2010 to discuss the rate increase. Unfortunately, I will be unable to attend, as I have an international business trip that is scheduled on that same date. I am writing to request a postponement of that meeting.
