**STATUS REPORT:**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has been working with Don C. Blonquist, a director with the Six Feathers Water Company (Company). The Division requested documentation from the Company regarding the delivery and construction of the water system. The development is located in mountainous terrain, where snow and recently a mud slide and flooding have damaged the road to the cabins sites and the water system. As such, Mr. Blonquist has not been able to obtain access to the water system, nor has been able to document the water system with an engineer. There is a meeting scheduled for tomorrow with oil developers and other land owners to determine how to resolve the access issues. Mr. Blonquist anticipates that they should be able to gain access within the next few weeks, where he plans to complete the documentation of the water system for the Division's review to insure a safe and reliable system will be provided.
