RECOMMENDATION: APPROVE

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve WaterPro's proposed changes to page 6 of its current tariff to reflect the actual costs charged to WaterPro by Epic Engineering for Engineering Plan Review Fee and Engineering Fee. WaterPro collects the Engineering Fee from the customer (developer) and passes it through to Epic Engineering. Additionally, this tariff filing accurately reflects the changes per the instructions from the Administrative Law Judge, Melanie Reif, during the February 4, 2005 hearing for Docket No. 12-2443-01 regarding this matter.
