ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION AND CANCELLING HEARING

ISSUED: January 8, 2014

I. BACKGROUND

On November 25, 2013, North Creek Ranch Home Owner's Association ("North Creek") filed a request to amend its water service rate schedule to, in part, increase its connection fee for a 1" meter connection charge from \$1,000 to \$2,000, and to increase the service connection fee for turn-on service where a meter is already in place from \$100 to \$200.

On December 20, 2013, the Division of Public Utilities ("Division")

recommended the Commission deny the proposed changes. <u>See</u> Division Memo, filed December 20, 2013 ("Division's Memo").

Based on the Division's Memo and Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(5)(b), the Commission suspended the proposed modifications to North Creek's water service rate schedule pending a hearing scheduled for Friday, January 24, 2014, at 8:30 a.m. <u>See</u> Order Suspending Proposed Changes to Connection and Turn-On Fees, Notice of Hearing, and Order, issued December 26, 2013.

On January 7, 2014, North Creek withdrew its application and requested cancellation of the hearing scheduled for January 24, 2014. <u>See</u> E-mail from Phillip Jolley, Secretary, North Creek, to Commission (Jan. 7, 2014; 10:24 AM). North Creek notes it "may still file a rate case in the future. . . ." <u>Id.</u>

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II. ORDER

Based on North Creek's withdrawal, and for other good cause appearing, North

Creek's application is dismissed and the hearing scheduled for January 24, 2014, at 8:30 a.m., is cancelled.
