

As noted by counsel for Eagles Landing Water Company LLC, the 1:30 p.m. time does not work for him or his associate. The 9:30 a.m. time, however, does work.

If it helps clarify things further for complainants, the scheduling conference is not a proceeding on the record. It does not involve making arguments, taking positions, or giving testimony. It is simply an informal meeting to discuss and determine the schedule in the matter. Again, any party may participate by phone.
