## LETTER OF EXEMPTION NO. 231

Dear Mr. Dillman,

The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) has reviewed your January 6, 2017 email, in which you request a letter exempting a correctional facility owned and operated by the State of Utah from regulations applicable to water corporations.

You have made the following representations:

- 1. Salt Lake City will provide wholesale water to the site of the correctional facility.
- 2. Once water is delivered into secure areas of the site, an internal water system will be managed by Department of Corrections staff, including certified operators.
- 3. The Department of Corrections will not sell water to consumers or bill consumers for water service.

Utah Code Ann. § 54-2-1(35) exempts from PSC jurisdiction water corporations that are determined to be "governmental units created or organized under any general or special law of this state." The PSC finds that a state-owned correctional facility meets this exemption.

Please be advised that this Letter of Exemption No. <u>231</u> is granted pursuant to the representations contained in your January 6, 2017 email. The Department of Corrections has a continuing obligation to update the Commission within 30 days of any change in those representations.
