6	time set for the public witness hearing in the matter of	
7	WaterPro, Inc. application increase in Docket	
8	No. 20-2443-01. Do we have anyone on the telephone, who	
9	is a public witness, who would like to say anything	
10	regarding WaterPro's application?	
11	MS. CRUMP: Do we just speak out when we	
12	hear you?	
13	MS. HOGLE: What I need you to do is for you	
14	to please state your name.	
15	MS. CRUMP: Okay.	
16	MS. HOGLE: And then give a recitation of	
17	whatever your comments may be, please.	
18	THE WITNESS: My name is Peggy Crump. I	
19	live on Willow Springs Lane. I just wanted to listen to	
20	all that you have to share with us today. And then if I	
21	have any comments, I will speak at the end, but I just	
22	wanted to listen. Thank you.	
23	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Miss Crump. Can you	
24	spell your name, please, for the record?	
25	THE WITNESS: Peggy, P-e-g-g-y, Crump,	

C-r-u-m-p.

MS. HOGLE: Thank you, Ms. Crump. The evidentiary part of the hearing or the evidentiary hearing was held this morning at 11:00. This portion of the hearing is the public witness hearing. And all that we are doing at this time is taking public comment on WaterPro's application. So you will not hear anything regarding the application, other than from public witnesses as yourself.

So, please take this opportunity to make any comment that you wish regarding the application because there will be no other comment from the applicant or anyone else that took part this morning at 11:00.

MS. CRUMP: Okay. Thank you. I have no comment.

MR. WOOD: My name is Steve Wood. That is S-t-e-v-e W-o-o-d. I am a Draper resident and I, like Peggy, was hoping to better understand the reasons for a rate increase. Obviously, the newsletter did not cover that nor the proposed amount of the rate increase. And I guess my question is; why weren't citizens allowed to observe, listen or have information as to what WaterPro is proposing and the amount of the rate increases they're proposes versus doing it behind closed doors in the dark, and then having a public comment meeting when,

basically, everything is pretty much said and done already?

MS. HOGLE: Thank you, Mr. Wood. This is
Yvonne Hogle, the presiding officer in this docket. I
will tell you as far as the Commission is concerned
there were appropriate notices, public notices, that
were provided to the public, who will be affected by
this rate increase and everything that we received from
utilities, including water utilities, is on our website.
But I believe that in addition to that, there were some
notices and bills that were provided to citizens who
will be affected by WaterPro's application. So,
therefore, what we're addressing here was not done in
any way under closed doors. It's been an open process.

THE WITNESS: Ma'am --

MS. HOGLE: At this time, I would like to give -- At this time, I would like to give an opportunity to Mr. Jensen-Peterson to provide details about any notices that he is aware of that were provided to the citizens who will be affected by this rate increase if he so wishes. He doesn't have to if he's on the phone or also, the Division of Public Utilities if they are on, I would also invite them to comment on this, specifically regarding the notices that were given to citizens who will be affected by this applicant's

1 application for a rate increase. And then I will give 2 you an opportunity, Mr. Wood. 3 MR. WOOD: Thank you. 4 MR. JENSEN-PETERSON: This is Darrin 5 Jensen-Peterson general manager of WaterPro. We did 6 send out in our July 1st notification regarding one, the hearing and then information regarding to go to our 7 website to find all information regarding this. 8 9 that -- On our website, we have our -- where it talks 10 about the public notice and then the proposed rate 11 increase listing what the rates are going to -- in 12 effect showing that it's a 5 percent increase across the 13 board. So that information was given out within a 14 timely manner prior to this. 15 I apologize. I wasn't sure if MS. HOGLE: 16 you were done. Go ahead, Mr. Jensen-Peterson. MR. JENSEN-PETERSON: 17 Also, within the 18 newsletter and on the website, we did indicate that if 19 anyone had any concerns or comments to contact us 20 directly at the office. And prior to this meeting and 21 still after this meeting, I am more than happy to sit

over the reasons for the increases, our last increase was in 2017, why we felt that it was important to

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down with any of our residents or on the phone, more or

less -- we're not doing in-person any longer -- to go

1 continue to go forward with this increase. This -- This 2 is a process with working with the Division and the 3 Commission that started when we had our approval back as 4 far as with -- our board approved the rates at the end of 2019 and then started the process in January. 5 quite a lengthy process going and working with the 6 Division. But we tried to give as much information as 7 we possibly could once we knew where we were going to 8 9 be, which we didn't come into a settlement agreement 10 with the Division until the end of June, and that's when 11 we went forward going to show what we were proposing 12 moving forward with this rate increase. That's all I 13 have. 14 MS. HOGLE: Thank you, Mr. Jensen-Peterson. 15 Does the Division of Public Utilities wish address 16 Mr. Wood's concern at this time? 17 MS. SCHMID: This is Patricia Schmid, the 18 attorney representing the Division. The Division worked 19 with WaterPro to facility notice to the customers and 20 the Division has nothing to add to WaterPro's comments 21 today. 22 Okay. Mr. Wood, but I -- before MS. HOGLE: 23 I let you respond to that, let me also tell you that 24 even after we close this public witness hearing, you 25 also still have an opportunity to provide written

comments once you have reviewed the information that 1 2 Mr. Jensen-Peterson referenced just a little while ago, 3 and the commission will take that into consideration 4 when it considers the settlement stipulation that was also referenced, but please, go ahead. 5 6 MR. WOOD: Thank you. I have your newsletter that came with the water billing for July. 7 And it's titled, "July Current Events." In there, it 8 9 does state that if you wish to participate or make any 10 comments you can do so on a telephone call on July 11 the 29th, today, which I am on. It also says that if 12 you have more information, you can go to our website 13 www.WaterPro.net. I visited that site, and I was unable to access any information relevant to a price increase. 14 I did not attempt multiple times to do that. I did, 15 16 upon receipt of this notice, attempt to do that. I was 17 unable, again, to get any information off the website. 18 Obviously, I think that things were done. 19 If you already negotiated in June well before this 20 notice came out -- again, my statement stands, or my 21 feelings stand, this was developed, decided and, 22 evidently, approved back in June then the public gets 23 the opportunity to comment. That's all I have to say. 24 Thank you.
