On March 15, 2018 the Utah Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) held a Technical Conference in this Docket. Utah Rural Telecom Association (“URTA”) and CenturyLink were the only parties that submitted an issues list for the March 15, 2018 Technical Conference. URTA, CenturyLink, the Division of Public Utilities (the “Division”), the Office of Consumer Services (the “Office”) and the Commission participated in the Technical Conference. At the Technical Conference, CenturyLink and URTA agreed to incorporate their identified issues into a proposed rule that could be circulated to all parties to this docket and then discussed at another Technical Conference. On March 16, 2018, CenturyLink filed a Request for Technical Conference. The Commission issued a Notice of Technical Conference on April 4, 2018 setting the Technical Conference for April 24, 2018 at 1:30 p.m.

URTA and CenturyLink need additional time to finalize the draft of the proposed rule. URTA has conferred with the CenturyLink, the Office and the Division regarding continuing the Technical Conference to a later date. All parties are available on May 14, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. URTA has also confirmed that this time is available for the Commission. Therefore, URTA request that the Technical Conference be rescheduled to Monday, May 14, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. CenturyLink, the Division, and the Office join in this motion.
