H.B. 66, Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Act,¹ will become effective on May 12, 2020. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-3-301, the Public Service Commission has 180 days following the bill’s effective date to initiate rulemaking proceedings.^{2,3} Interested parties may submit comments on the specific issues to address in the rules on or before **Tuesday, June 16, 2020**, and may submit reply comments and proposed rule language by **Tuesday, July 21, 2020**.
