PETITION OF THE UTAH INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS TO INTERVENE

In accordance with Rule 756-100-6 of the Public Service Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and the Provisions at Utah Code Ann. § 63-46b-9, Abbott Critical Care, Fairchild Semiconductor, Amoco Petroleum Products/Salt Lake, Holnam, Inc., Kimberly-Clark Corporation, Micron Technology, Inc., Praxair, Inc., Western Zirconium, and Kennecott Utah Copper Corporation, (hereinafter and throughout the course of this proceeding referred to as "Utah Industrial Energy Consumers" or "UIEC"), hereby move the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-referenced proceeding.

In support of this Petition to Intervene, the UIEC state as follows:

1. PacifiCorp, dba Utah Power & Light (“PacifiCorp”) has filed an Application with the Commission for approval of an increase in its rates and changes. It has also filed an Emergency Motion for an Interim Rate Increase.

2. The UIEC are a group of customers who take service from PacifiCorp under Rate Schedule 9 or under Special Contracts.

3. The UIEC have a direct, immediate and substantial interest in this proceeding as customers of PacifiCorp because the availability of electrical power, the rate they pay for electric service, and their willingness and/or ability to continue service arrangements with PacifiCorp may be affected by a decision of the Commission on PacifiCorp’s Application.

4. The interest of the UIEC will not be adequately represented by any other party to this proceeding.

5. If the UIEC is granted intervention, they hereby request that service of all pleadings, notices, etc. be made to the following:
