Subject: MSP Mediation Process

A few weeks ago, I was asked to rejoin the MSP in a more active role as a "Mediator", to work with you to file a joint recommendation to the State Commissions.

The following Mediation Process, which has the endorsement of the Utah PSC and the Oregon PUC, has the goal of filing a comprehensive settlement of MSP issues on or before May 10, 2004. The Process is designed to achieve agreement among as many parties as possible from each state by the filing date.

- April 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>** : OR Staff, DPU, and Company confer to draft a settlement document. The initial draft is being prepared by the Company under my guidance, and will be available by April 7<sup>th</sup>.
- April 13<sup>th</sup>** : Circulate draft settlement document to all MSP parties.
- April 14<sup>th</sup>** : UT Tech Conference to discuss draft settlement document.
- April 21<sup>st</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup>** : Parties interested in pursuing settlement will meet to draft a final settlement document and outline supporting testimony (all day in Boise).
- April 23<sup>rd</sup> – May 7<sup>th</sup>** : Settlement document and supporting testimony and exhibits are finalized; each party decides whether to support the settlement document in the filing.
- May 10<sup>th</sup>** : Filing in multiple states of settlement document and supporting testimony.

In addition to the dates and meetings listed above, I will contact and try to meet with each party. Additional meetings dates may also be added if necessary. Once the filing is made in each state, additional procedural milestones will be established for public processes and hearings as needed.
