By The Commission:

On October 31, 2002, PacifiCorp submitted a proposed tariff, No. 44, addressing procedures for sales of power from Qualifying Facilities with a design capacity greater than 1,000 kW. PacifiCorp requested that the tariff become effective on November 7, 2002. Since the original filing, comments on the proposed tariff have been filed by the Division of Public Utilities, the Committee on Consumer Services and by Renewable Energy Systems, North America, Inc./Richard Collins. These comments have proposed modifications to the proposed tariff. In order to provide PacifiCorp an opportunity to respond to these and any other comments that may be submitted, the Commission will suspend the tariff and consider all comments and responses submitted before considering the merits of the tariff proposal and modifications thereto, if any.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The proposed PacifiCorp Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 44 is suspended pending further Order of the Commission.
- Additional comments on the proposed tariff should be submitted and served upon PacifiCorp and other interested persons by November 29, 2002. PacifiCorp may respond to any comments submitted, and may do so no later than December 13, 2002.
