The Division of Public Utilities, the Committee of Consumer Services and PacifiCorp have reached agreement on the following proposed schedule for this proceeding.

April 9	Intervenor Direct Testimony
April 28	Rebuttal Testimony
May 6-7	Hearings

In order to address the problems associated with the relatively short time between Intervenor Direct and Rebuttal Testimony filing dates, PacifiCorp also proposes a five day response time for data requests filed on or after April 9. That would provide parties with an opportunity to receive responses to data requests in time to incorporate them into their rebuttal testimony.

The proposed schedule was also sent to counsel for US Magnesium and Desert Power, but, as yet, we have not received comments from those parties.


