By The Commission:

On September 24, 2003, this Commission issued an order in this docket directing PacifiCorp to file for approval, within 60 days, a revised avoided cost method. That filing date was subsequently extended to January 23, 2004, to provide the QF work group additional time to discuss unresolved issues.

On January 14, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Motion to Extend Filing Date. In that motion PacifiCorp stated that it intends to include testimony with its revised avoided cost filing to provide "a more complete explanation of the basis" for its position. As a result of pending cases before this and other regulatory bodies, however, PacifiCorp stated that it requires additional time to prepare and file that testimony. PacifiCorp represented that the Division of Public Utilities, the Committee of Consumer Services and US Magnesium do not oppose the requested extension.

For good cause appearing, we grant the motion.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the filing date for PacifiCorp's revised avoided cost method is extended to February 3, 2004.
