RE: Pole Attachment Inventory

PacifiCorp will be conducting a pole attachment inventory of our seven state service territory over the next twenty-four months. The inventory will be conducted by a contractor hired by PacifiCorp for the express purpose of collecting data on pole attachments. The contractor will identify and record all non-Company attachments to PacifiCorp poles and PacifiCorp attachments to non-PacifiCorp poles in our mutual service territory. The attachment inventory will become our inventory of record for all future annual pole attachment rental billings.

A tentative schedule covering the remainder of 1996 is attached for your reference.

The minimum recording accuracy of attachments placed on the contractor is 97% on each facility map. Facility maps will be selected at random for field verification on data recording accuracy by this office. If your organization desires to validate the data capture procedures or the accuracy of the data, either at initial point of collection or during the verification process, supply me the name, address, phone and fax number of your representative and I will make the arrangement.

PacifiCorp will be sharing the inventory cost with all of its joint use partners. The cost sharing will be a percentage of the per pole cost. Telecommunication Service Providers (CAPS, CATV, OTHERS) will pay 50% of the per pole cost for each PacifiCorp pole they are solely attached to. The Local Exchange Provider (Telephone Company) will pay 50% of the per pole cost for each PacifiCorp pole they are solely attached to and the telephone company will pay 100% of the per pole cost for each telephone company pole PacifiCorp is attached to. PacifiCorp poles which have multiple parties on the same pole will share the per pole cost equally. PacifiCorp has estimated the inventory data collection cost will be \$0.80 per pole.

PacifiCorp, by agreement, may also assess an unauthorized pole attachment fee when warranted.

All Telecommunications Service Providers will pay 50% of the per pole cost for each PacifiCorp pole they are solely attached too. All Telecommunications Service Providers that own and maintain poles, will pay 50% of the per pole cost for each pole PacifiCorp has an attached on. PacifiCorp poles which have multiple parties on the same pole will share the per pole cost equally. PacifiCorp's cost for this inventory is \$0.80 per pole.

PacifiCorp may also assess an unauthorized pole attachment fee where warranted.
