2. Data requests served on or after December 3, 2004 related to revenue requirement, and January 7, 2005 regarding cost of service and rate design, parties will respond within five (5) business days. Data requests served on or after February 4, 2005 related to revenue requirement, and those served on or after February 14, 2005 on cost of service and rate design, parties will respond within five (5) calendar days.

3. The parties shall, if possible, serve all filings and discovery by electronic mail. If any party does not have an electronic mail address or is unable to send documents by electronic mail, service shall, if possible, be by facsimile. If a party has neither an electronic mail address nor a facsimile number or a party is unable to serve documents by electronic mail or facsimile, documents shall be served by hand delivery or overnight courier at the discretion of the serving party.
