On November 16, 2007, in response to an Action Request, the Division submitted a memorandum to the Commission commenting on the Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) Low Income Arrearage Study Report, Docket No. 05-035-54 and recommended the Commission not acknowledge the report as satisfying the Acquisition Commitment U26.

On January 9, 2008, the Division met with RMP and discussed the Division's concerns regarding the Arrearage report. As a result of this meeting the Company agreed to obtain additional information from Quantec regarding its arrearage report. The Company further agreed that it would provide information, with as much detail as currently available, regarding how the Company will proceed in this matter. The Division believes that this information will potentially alleviate our concerns. Therefore, upon review of this information, the Division will submit amended comments and recommendations.
