Subject: Power in Green River

At the conclusion of our meeting with Rocky Mountain Power last year their engineer and consultant were told to look at my pump because Rocky Mountain Power felt that my pump was the problem. We torn my pump apart and the Rocky Mountain Power consultant said that my pump was just fine. The problem is that I was told I could hook on 250 hp on one line and they have hooked on one or two more people on this line after I was told there was only 250 hp. In town on the line that we were told we could hook on 750 hp and no more, Rocky Mountain Power from April 1st to April 13th have been setting power poles to hook on two more users with irrigation pumps. They keep telling me there is no more power yet they keep hooking people on, forcing me to use diesel, which is at an all time high. I am requesting a hearing ASAP to determine why I can't get power and yet they have power for everyone else. After finding out that my pump was not the problem Rocky Mountain Power has not addressed what the problem is and once again we are heading into irrigation season with no answers and more people hooking on. I await your answer and you will probably hear from me tomorrow. I hope to have this resolved soon. Tim Vetere

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
