Based on the request of PacifiCorp and being fully advised, the Commission makes the following order regarding the schedule in this docket.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The following revised schedule for rate design and cost of service shall apply in this proceeding:

Intervenor Direct Testimony	September 27, 2006
All Parties Rebuttal Testimony	October 16, 2006, by noon
All Parties Surrebuttal Testimony	October 23, 2006
Hearings	October 27, 2006, beginning at 8:30 a.m., October 30, 2006, beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending at noon, all hearings will be held in Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building
Public Witness Day	October 27, 2006, beginning at 11:30 a.m. until concluded, in Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building

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2. Regarding data requests served on or after August 30, 2006, parties will respond within seven (7) business days. Regarding data requests served on or after September 27, 2006, parties will respond within five (5) business days. Regarding data requests served on or after October 23, 2006, parties will respond within three (3) business days.

3. The parties shall, if possible, serve all filings and discovery by electronic mail. If any party does not have an electronic mail address or is unable to send documents by electronic mail, service shall, if possible, be by facsimile. If a party has neither an electronic mail address nor a facsimile number or a party is unable to serve documents by electronic mail or facsimile, documents shall be served by hand delivery or overnight courier at the discretion of the serving party. It is understood that attachments or exhibits that are not available electronically and which are too bulky to be served by facsimile will be either hand-delivered or sent by overnight courier to parties who would otherwise be entitled to receive service of them by electronic mail or facsimile.
